**This walk will look at Falmer Court Farm's Downland, which is part of Brighton
Council's 12,000 acre Downland Estate.**

**It has wonderful relict species-rich flowery turf (with rare archaic grassland
fungi, Burnet Rose - smelling of Lilies of the Valley - Meadow Pipit, Skylark,
Yellowhammer, Chalk Milkwort, Rockrose, orchids, Pride of Sussex Rampion,
Betony, Devils Bit), TWO ancient monuments, and neighbours the Castle Hill
National Nature Reserve and SSSI.**

**...Yet it has been abused, terribly neglected, and super-exploited for many
decades by both Brighton Council and its tenant farmers.**

**Come prepared for open-air discussion and debate on how
we should manage our public land and our farming and
construct an eco-socialist countryside !!**
